## LIGHT BODIED, ELEGANT DRY WHITE

- 1. Chateau du Poyet, V. Vignes, Muscadet de Sevre et Maine Sur Lie 2007** £19.95  
**Loire, France**  
Is there a fish in the house? If so, reach for this brilliant Loire white.
- 2. Domaine de Luzanet, Vin de Pays des Cotes de Gascogne 2008** £20.50  
**South West France, France (12% abv)** 175ml Glass £5.25  
Bold, intensely aromatic white wine with delicious green fruit flavours.
- 3. Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine Roquemoliere 2008** £21.95  
**Languedoc Roussillon, France**  
The South of France's secret weapon, the Picpoul is a zippy and mouth-watering partner for any kind of seafood.
- 4. Pinot Grigio, Vigneto Cantarelle, Le Vigne 2008** £23.05  
**Veneto, Italy (12% abv)** 175ml Glass £5.78  
This Pinot Grigio is tops – slightly spicy and extremely moreish.
- 5. Chablis, Domaine de Vauroux 2007** £30.75  
**Burgury, France (12.5% abv)** 175ml Glass £7.65  
When it absolutely has to be the best, steely, minerally Chablis hits the spot like nothing else.

## AROMATIC, DRY WHITES WITH EXCELLENT FRUIT ACIDITY

- 6. Chenin Blanc, Stormy Cape 2007** £19.15  
**Western Cape, South Africa**  
A honeyed delight which will partner all kinds of dishes with ease.
- 7. Sauvignon Blanc Reserva, De Gras 2008** £23.65  
**Colchagua, Valley Chile (13.5% abv)** 175ml Glass £6.05  
Elegant Chilean Sauvignon as suave as James Bond and equally exciting.
- 8. Gruner Veltliner, Hopley 2007/08** £26.35  
**Burgenland, Austria**  
This grape is called 'Gruo-vey' by some, and with reason: it's hip, happening and bang up to date with its spicy, fine lines. Drink in good company.
- 9. Gavi di Bavi DOCG Fontanafredda 2007/08** £31.85  
**Piemonte, Italy**  
Incredibly fist-friendly Italian white from masters of the art.
- 10. Pouilly Fume, Chateau Favray 2007** £32.45  
**Loire, France**  
Pouilly Fume – the top Sauvignon Blanc appellation in the Loire Valley – is simply smokin'.
- 11. Viognier VPD de la Principaute d'Orange, Janasse 2008** £39.95  
**Chateauneuf-Du-Pape, France**  
The nose is fresh, fruity and aromatic, with ripe tropical and dried fruit characteristics.

## **WHITE WINES**

### **RICH & FULL BODIED**

- 12. Painter Bridge Chardonnay, J. Lohr 2007/08** **£20.85**  
**California, United States of America (13% abv)** **175ml Glass £5.50**  
Smooth, lean and handsome / a typical Californian in other words ...
- 13. Brauneberger Juffer Riesling Kabinett, Paulshof 2007** **£26.95**  
**Mosel, Germany (10% abv)** **175ml Glass £6.75**  
A classic, fresh lemony fragrance on the nose with an amazingly complex balance on the palate.
- 14. Chardonnay, Thelema Mountain vineyards 2006** **£34.05**  
**Western Cape, South Africa**  
Buxom and curvaceous Chardonnay – full bodied and extremely seductive.
- 15. Chablis 1er Cru Montmain, Domaine Pico-Race 2006** **£40.15**  
**Burgundy, France**  
First amongst equals, this fine Chablis will have you luxuriating in its finesse.
- 16. Chorey-Les-Beaune Blanc, Domaine Maillard Pere et Fils 2007** **£43.95**  
**Burgundy, France**  
The Brurgundians know a thing or two about great white wine, as this superb Chorey ably demonstrates.

- 17. Meursault 1er Cru Les Perrieres, Domaine Jean-Michel Gaunoux 2004** **£82.50**  
**Burgundy, France**  
Smoky, full-throttle fruit from the very best barrels in Burgundy. Top class stuff.
- 18. Puligny Montrachet, Henri Boillot 2006** **£115.00**  
**Meursault, France**  
Enticing, generous nose showing ripe melon and pears and well integrated, toasty oak.

# RED WINES

## LIGHTER, FRUITER REDS

19. **Falasco Corvina Veneto IGT, Cantina Valpantena 2008** £20.50  
**Veneto, Italy** 175ml Glass £5.25  
A well crafted wine all round with a good extract and solid structure.
20. **Escale Pinot Noir, Vin de Pays d'Oc 2008** £24.75  
**Languedoc, Roussillon, France (13% abv)** 175ml Glass £7.15  
Perfect Pinot from the sunny South of France, A crowd pleaser.
21. **Fleurie, Louis Tete 2007** £28.55  
**Burgury, France**  
As elegant as a vase of freshly picked flowers, red fruits abound in the glass.
22. **Dolcetta d'Alba, E. Pira 2007** £30.00  
**Piemonte, Italy**  
A direct fruitiness combined with soft tannins make it charmingly seductive.

## MEDIUM BODIED & SPICY

23. **St. Chinian, Domaine du Barres 2008** £19.15  
**Languedoc Roussillon, France (13.5%)** 175ml Glass £4.95  
A red for all occasions, nice soft fruit and a finish more like a caress.
24. **Rioja, Vina Cerrada 2008** £20.35  
**Rioja, Spain**  
There's a reason everyone likes Rioja, It's amazing, delicious, and so, so drinkable.
25. **Santa Ana Malbec, Bodegas Santa Ana 2008** £21.95  
**Mendoza, Argentina**  
Malbec is the new rock n'roll in the red wine world. Grab a glass and join the party.
26. **Shiraz Viogner, Indis 2005** £22.55  
**Western Australia, Australia (13.5%)** 175ml Glass £6.55  
Australian for 'red wine'. Punchy, fruity and very good indeed.
27. **Merlot Reserva, De Gras 2007** £23.65  
**Colchagua Valley, Chile (14.5% abv)** 175ml Glass £6.05  
Effortlessly delicious red from our Chilean friends. A South American adventure in taste.
28. **Hawkes Bay Pinot Noir, Trinity Hill 2008** £30.75  
**Hawkes Bay, New Zealand**  
Hawkes Bay is New Zealand's latest great winemaking area to be discovered by us wine adventurers  
... pretty glad we came!
29. **Merlot, Thelema Mountain Vineyards 2006** £37.95  
**Western Cape, South Africa**  
"Show me the Merlot!" you will shout when you get a first taste of this Cape beauty.

- 30. Prelude a Grand Puy Ducesse 2003** **£54.00**  
**Pauillac, France**  
 Almost opaque colour with deep cherry and tobacco elegance on the nose.

## **RED WINES**

### **FULL BODIED & STRUCTURED REDS**

- 31. Brolio, Chianti Classico 2007** **£28.05**  
**Tuscany, Italy (13.5% abv)** **175ml Glass £7.50**  
 Brilliant, beautiful Brolio - a Chianti of true greatness.

- 32. Cabernet Sauvignon, Zordernaam 2004/05** **£29.15**  
**Western Cape, South Africa**  
 Chunky, chocolatey cab from South Africa – brawny and bold.

- 33. Chateau Pey La Tour Reserve, Bordeaux Superieur 2006** **£31.85**  
**Bordeaux, France (13.5% abv)** **175ml Glass £7.65**  
 A classic claret – all black fruit, cedar box and structure – ‘Superieur’ in every way!

- 34. Rioja Reserva, Margues de Riscal 2004** **£32.45**  
**Rioja, Spain**  
 Marques de Riscal have 150 years experience of making wine in Rioja. They have learned quite a bit as you can see.

- 35. Chateauneuf du Pape, Domaine Chante Cigale 2005/06** **£45.00**  
**Rhone, France**  
 Apparently there are 13 different grapes used in Chateauneuf du Pape. All you need to know is that it tastes amazing.

- 36. Barolo di Serralunga d’Alba DOCG, Fontanafredda 2004** **£55.00**  
**Piemonte, Italy**  
 Finesse in a glass from these North Italian masters. 2004 was Barolo’s greatest vintage for years.

- 37. Brunello di Montalcino Riserva, Fattoria dei Barbi 2003** **£90.00**  
**Montalcino, Italy**  
 A classical top Brunello to bring to your table the best flavours of Tuscany. Full body, ripe cherry. moreish palate ..... this wine will blow your mind!

- 38. Chateau Leoville Barton, St. Julien 2000** **£160.00**  
**Pauillac, France**  
 Intensely concentrated nose with enormous amounts of tobacco, mocha, liquorice and cassis aromas.

## ROSE WINES

- 39. Chateau Gassier, Cotes de Provence 2007** **£24.15**  
**Provence, France (12.5% abv)** **175ml Glass £6.80**  
This wine comes from rose's spiritual home, Provence, and it is steeped in pink pedigree.
- 40. Notley Gorge Pinot Noir Rose, Rosevear Estate 2007** **£28.50**  
**Tasmania, Australia**  
The Australian summer is captured in this full-bodied rose.

## SPARKLING WINE

- 41. Argeo, Prosecco Brut, Ruggeri NV** **£26.95**  
**Veneto, Italy (11% abv)** **flute £5.50**  
Prosecco is the kind of delicious, pear-scented drink whose bubbles simply mean you want more of it – immediately!

## CHAMPAGNE

- 42. Brut Souverain, Henriot NV** **½ bottle £30.00**  
**Champagne, France**  
Fresh, well-balanced and harmonious on the palate.
- 43. Brut Souverain, Henriot NV** **£49.00**  
**Champagne, France (12% abv)** **flute £8.75**  
Fresh, well-balanced and harmonious on the palate.
- 44. Brut Rose, Henriot NV** **£60.00**  
**Champagne, France**  
The Henriot rose epitomises elegance combined with remarkable concentration on the palate, great balance and attractive aromas of red fruits.
- 45. Blanc Souverain Pur Chardonnay, Henriot NV** **£65.95**  
**Champagne, France**  
Quite simply stunning Champagne from the family-owned Henriot. Anyone drinking this is in very privileged company indeed.
- 46. Taittinger, Prelude Grand Cru NV** **£75.00**  
**Champagne, France**  
Fresh citrus fruit flavours give way to a much fuller, well bodied and mellow taste.
- 47. Bollinger, Special Cuvee NV** **£77.00**  
**Champagne, France**  
Things go better with Bolly.

- 48. Perrier Jouet, Belle Epoque 1999** **£132.00**  
**Champagne, France**  
Magnificent greenish gold in colour with a chrySTALLine brightness and a strong, intense effervescence with fine a regular bubbles.
- 49. Krug, Grande Cuvee NV** **£187.00**  
**Champagne, France**  
Undoubtedly the King of Champagne Krug consistently produces the finest wines that Champagne have to offer.

## DESSERT WINES

- 50. Aleatico di Puglia, Francesco Candido 2002** **50cl Bottle £20.85**  
**Puglia, Italy (14% abv)** **75ml Glass £6.50**  
Broad and rich with a medium sweet, velvety palate supported by good acidity.
- 51. Moscato d'Asti DOCG, Bricco Quaglia, La Spinetta 2008** **£27.50**  
**Piemonte, Italy (4.5% abv)** **flute £7.50**  
Moscato d'Asti Bricco Quaglia is the wine that made Giorgio Rivetti famous both in Italy and abroad.
- 52. Clos Dady, Sauternes 2006** **½ Bottle £28.00**  
**Bordeaux, France (13.5% abv)** **75ml Glass £7.50**  
This is the Daddy of sweet wines from the legendary Sauternes.
